

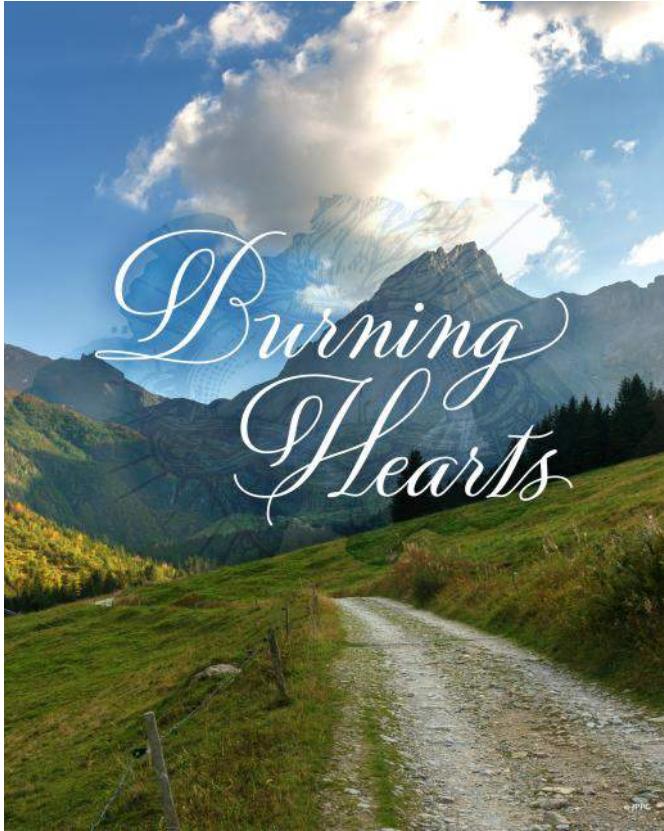

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle.

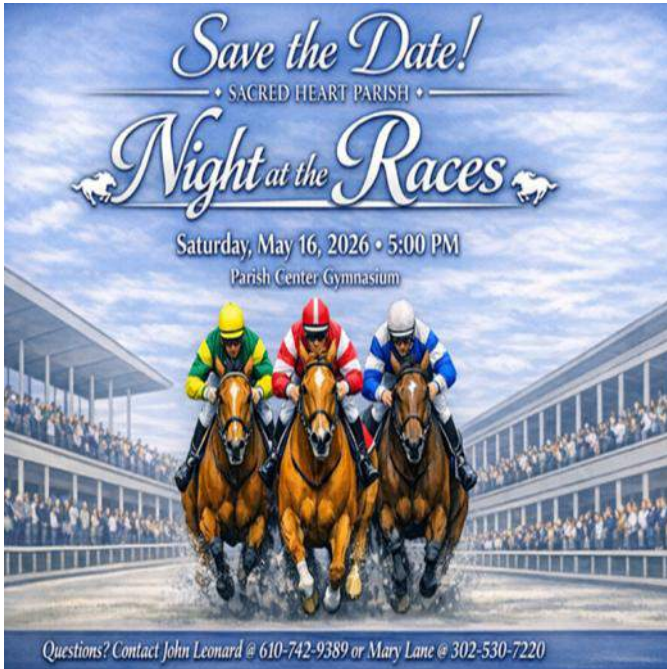
Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil.

At checkout, the cashier turned to me and said the paper I picked was on sale! The cost was only \$7.35. God not only helped me find money but gave some back to me. I realize there is nothing too small to ask God for help. This is my little miracle.

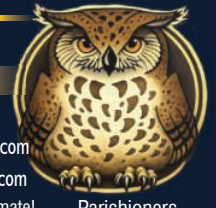
