



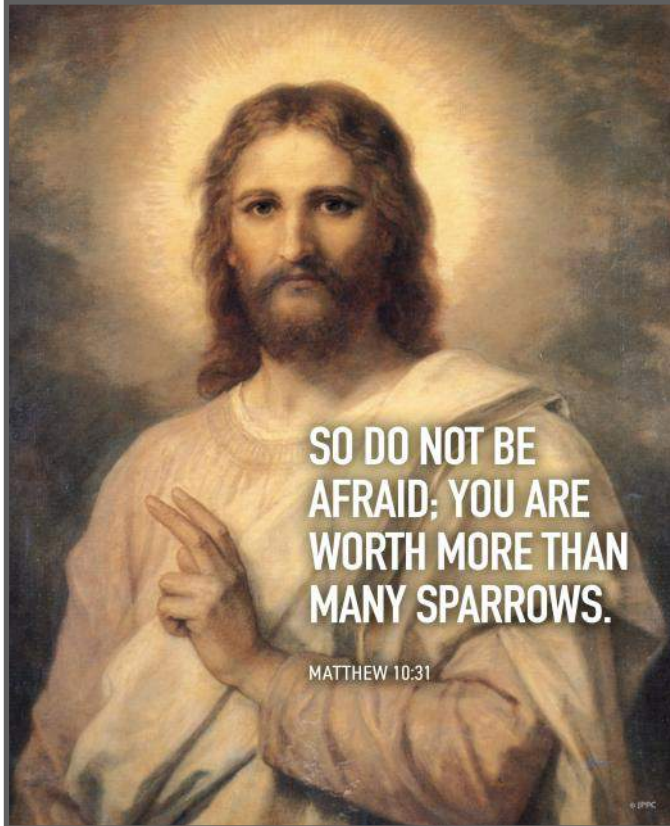

## ~ Prayer to Saint Michael ~

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle.

Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil.

May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

## Miracles Happen Here

Vatican II altered the Catholic Church. Some would argue that it was for the better. One undeniable result of the sweeping changes in the past 60 years had been the lessening of devotion to Our Blessed Mother. The "Jesus movement" on college campuses in the 70's further hastened the turn away from our Mother as Catholic students who had had no appreciable training in the reasons we venerate her, could not defend against the onslaught of "saved" classmates who outwardly mocked the religion of their youth.

The following story comes from a friend in the diocese of Trenton NJ:

After dating the son of a Methodist minister throughout high school and some years afterward, I was subjected repeatedly to all the Protestant arguments used against Catholics. One of the condescending rants was how Catholics are "not allowed" to read the Bible. So when it became clear that not only were we allowed, but encouraged, I began to enjoy reading my Bible. While the boyfriend became history, I continued reading scripture, and listening to the "on fire" evangelical preachers on the radio who have no love for Our Lady. As my sisters got more and more into the faith, and spoke of praying the rosary with piety and reverence, I decided to try it even though my all of my pastors through the years were less than enthusiastic about the devotion. I felt nothing at all, but kept it up, remembering how our Grandmom and mom had always prayed with their beads. I read in the Bible how it is wrong to "multiply words" in prayer and felt convinced that the rosary was doing exactly what we had been told NOT to do. I was praying about this very question one day while driving. I told the Lord I have misgivings about the way we have been taught to pray in reverence to His Mother and that I get no inspiration from the rosary. It was at that very second, I saw the vanity plate of the car in front of me – It said "Fatima 1". Unique in the entire state of NJ with its over 2.2 million registered vehicles, this one was directly in front of me – just as I prayed about the validity of the devotion.

I know Our Mother is trying to get my attention. Lately, I try to listen.

The rosary was created by St. Peter the Hermit in 1090 and brought fully into the Catholic Church as a devotion by St. Dominic in 1214. The rosary and indeed, even a single Hail Mary said with the welfare

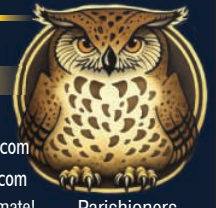
