The Forty Hours Devotion

June 7, 8, 9, 2026



The Forty Hours Devotion is a special forty-hour period of prayer made before the Blessed Sacrament in solemn exposition. The focus of this devotion is on the Holy Eucharist. As Catholics, the words of Our Lord burn in our hearts: *"I myself am the living bread come down from Heaven. If anyone eats this bread, He shall live forever; the bread I will give is my flesh for the life of the world"* (John 6:51).

Affirming our belief in the Real Presence of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, Vatican Council II taught that the Holy Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life" (Lumen Gentium, #11). While the Mass is the central act of worship for us Catholics, an act which participates in the eternal reality of Our Lord's passion, death, and resurrection, Vatican Council II upheld and encouraged the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament outside of Mass.

Sunday, June 7, 2026: At 6:15 PM, 40 Hour devotion opens with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and evening prayer with a homily. After these events, there will be an outdoor procession, weather permitting, and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Benediction. After processing back to the Church, Eucharistic Adoration will continue throughout the night until the 8:00 AM Mass on Monday.

Monday, June 8, 2026: At 8:00 AM, 40 hour devotion continues with the celebration of Holy Mass. After Mass, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. At 6:15 PM, we will have evening prayer with a homily and Benediction. The day will close with Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

Tuesday, June 9, 2026: At 10:00 AM, 40 hour devotion continues with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament until 6:00 p.m. From 5:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m., the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available. At 6:15 PM, there will be the closing Mass of the 40 Hours .



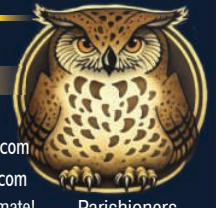
