~ Prayer to Saint Michael ~

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle.

Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil.

May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

Notice anything different about the altar today? Before I give away the answer, I have a story.

About an hour north of New York city is a rather nondescript office building. Inside, on a door in the middle of a hallway is a small sign: Adrian Hamers. It looks like the hallway to my dentist's office. After you knock, a different door opens further down the hallway for security.

You see, beyond that door is literally millions of dollars in gold. I was visiting Adrian Hamers to pick out my chalice for my first Mass as a priest. Some of the best tabernacles, monstrances and thuribles come from there. That's also where our new candle holders come from!

What's the focal point in Church? Jesus, proclaimed in the Gospel, made present at the altar, and reserved in the tabernacle. He (and you, His people) are what matter most of all.

We decorate and clean the Church for the same reason we decorate and clean our homes. To show the importance, dignity, and love of the people who live there. That's why I believe it's worth my time and yours to cultivate beauty and order; it's out of love for God and for each other!

Despite being so prominent our candle holders were not in great shape. There's actually some science and some sadness behind why. The science first! We used to use 7/8" diameter candles. The HVAC would blow them right out, so we added glass wind protectors. They'd get sooty and full of wax. But a wider candle has a stronger flame, which can just survive the wind! That's the main reason behind our upgrade, plus our desire for beauty in the liturgy.

What about the sadness? There's a lot to that. The candle stands weren't being maintained too well. I've been told it's really hard to get volunteers, but I don't know if that's true. Generally people want to help, they just don't know how. And with the priest shortage, who is there to teach, organize, or motivate them? That's a really hard part of being Catholic today. We're amidst a huge mindset shift from relying on our priests to do everything to being more laity-led. Perhaps it is by God's design: The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few.

There's an even worse shortage of religious women today. When I was ordering those candles over the phone, Mario Hamers taught me something. The real way to care for lacquered brass is to coat them in a mixture of mineral oil and Vaseline, which is what the nuns used to do. (Today we use Pledge). Brasso is an absolute no-go, which is why the lacquer coating is so often worn through. Without the nuns we've lost so much more than metal-care!

If you like the new candle stands and you'd like to contribute to beautifying the sanctuary please continue to tithe! If you'd like to help us with something specific, ask me about buying a matching cross for the altar. But most of all please pray for God to send us more priests and religious women.


