# From The PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

It is customary for many people to make “New Year’s Resolutions” at the beginning of the New Year. The goal in making these resolutions is that we will improve in some way. The beginning of a new year is an ideal time to set goals for ourselves because the change in the calendar year signifies a new start and the hope that things will be better in the future.

“A new beginning”, “a fresh start”, “hope for a better future” — these are all sentiments that are echoed in today’s readings for the Solemnity of the Epiphany. Our first reading is taken from the Old Testament Book of the Prophet Isaiah (60:1-6). Scripture scholars think that this passage was likely written during the time after the Jewish people returned to Jerusalem from exile in Babylon. When they returned, the Holy City was in ruins and the Temple had been destroyed. Yet out of this darkness, Isaiah proclaims the hope that all of the nations will see the splendor of Jerusalem and the light of the Lord shining upon His Chosen People. Jerusalem shall receive the wealth of the nations, including gold and frankincense.

Today’s Gospel from Saint Matthew (2:1-12) sees the ultimate fulfillment of Isaiah’s prophecy in the Christ Child. Jesus, the Lord in the flesh, is adorned by all of the nations as represented in the Magi, who come to adore Him and bring gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

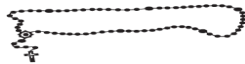
In a homily given at Midnight Mass on December 24, 2020, Pope Francis observes that all too often we try to nourish ourselves with food that does not satisfy. We seek entertainment, success, and worldly pleasures that only leave us empty. He notes: “That manger, poor in everything yet rich in love, teaches that true nourishment in life comes from letting ourselves be loved by God and loving others in turn.” (Magnificat, January 2023, p. 119).

I would like to propose a spiritual New Year’s resolution: as we begin a new calendar year, may we seize every opportunity to draw close to God, and to share His love with everyone around us.
