# Miracles Happen Here

Sometimes a miracle comes in the form of people and circumstances that are in the precise right place at the right time. Like the big fish that swallowed Jonah and spat him out on shore so that he did not drown in the tempestuous sea but lived to carry on the will of the One who had given him a mission, the following story from an anonymous parishioner is one such miracle.

As an 8th grader at a massive Catholic grade school in northwest Indiana, I was the head of the altar servers, played on the basketball team, a boy scout, and delivered the Chicago Tribune every morning. Early on Christmas morning, after serving midnight Mass on Christmas eve late the night before, I completed my route as the rest of the family awoke. We opened presents. One of mine was a rosary from the assistant pastor blessed by the Pope and holy water from Lourdes. My brother received a new bike. As I was the only one dressed for the cold Christmas morning, I moved my brother's bike into the garage. On my way back into the house, walking up the icy back step, I slipped and fell through the door. I severed an artery in my arm and started to bleed profusely. Blood squirted everywhere. I covered the wound quickly and my dad threw me in the car, no time to wait for an ambulance as I was bleeding out. My dad, the Marine, knew where the pressure point was for the artery and I used my head on top of my arm to apply pressure which I recalled from my boy scout first aid training. We drove to the nearest clinic which was poorly staffed on Christmas morning. I remember being wheeled past the patients in the waiting room thinking what a terrible way to spend Christmas morning, not realizing what a sight I was - soaked in blood from head to toe. Luckily the bleeding stopped before I passed out. With a pressure bandage applied and the on-call surgeon notified, I was back in Dad's car on the way to the hospital. They were waiting for me at the hospital but the surgery was delayed since my rare blood type meant blood had to be choppered in from Chicago for the complex surgery to come. Since my arm had been without blood for many hours, we opted to go with the team on hand rather than wait for my doctor's team. After 8 hours of surgery which included an arterial graft from my leg into my arm, I awoke. I still had an arm attached in a soft cast. The surgeon obviously never told me of the risk of amputation but he had prepared my parents for the possibility. He also prepared them for the real possibility that if I kept the arm, I would lose normal use of it given the muscles and nerves which were severed. He also said I wasn't out of the woods for losing the arm in coming days given how long it had been without blood. Gangrene could set in. I never knew any of that until months later.

Where's the miracle in all that you might ask? I later learned that the parish priest told everyone what happened to me at all Christmas Masses. I had a massive outpouring of prayers from the parish which I will never forget. I didn't bleed to death thanks in large part to my father remaining calm throughout the event. The surgeon on call, I found out well afterwards, was considered one of the best general surgeons in the region. The blood arrived in time. I not only recovered complete use of my arm, but actually played in an 8th grade basketball game in late February (much to the dismay of my mother)! I blessed that arm everyday with that holy water and prayed to the Blessed Mother. The surgeon would shake his head at every follow up visit about the amazing healing and the fully recovered use. I went onto play division 1 sports and that right arm never failed me. The Blessed Mother Mary was with me every step of the way. I never gave up hope; maybe I was too young to understand the risks. Or, maybe that's what faith is all about.

You bet I believe in miracles.



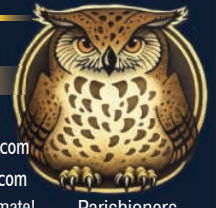
