## *~ Prayer to Saint Michael ~*

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle.

Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil.

## Miracles Happen Here

There is a Biblical concept called *hesed*. The term encompasses the ideas of enduring commitment, covenant loyalty, benevolence, and deep compassion. The loyalty it evokes is so deep when referencing God's *hesed* to us, that we see it as a promise which stretches right down to us personally from our ancestors. The recipient of the following miracle learned firsthand of God's promise to be with us forever in a terrifying incident which ended in a miracle and changed her forever.

From Alyssa Marie visitor to Sacred Heart Tuesday Reconciliation:

For about a year, I was in a domestic abuse relationship. In the final assault, the boy bashed me full-force on the left side of my head with his hard and heavy desk fan. Truthfully, given the force with which he hit me, I owe it only to a miracle of grace from the LORD that I survived that blow. Never had I been more terrified; I knew he would easily kill me. I will never forget this next moment of clarity, as he continued to scream in my face: a Voice spoke to the depths of my heart, saying, "Do not look at him, Alyssa. Watch his hands with Me." I obeyed. I watched his hands *so* scrupulously. Praise God that He gave me the grace to listen to Him! Blessed be that still, sweet Voice of the Beloved. The boy quickly tried to hit me a second time with the fan. It was full-strength and quick as lightning, but because I was watching his hands, with all my speed and strength, I blocked it. My arms went cruciform. I could hardly see my arm at this point because of the blood. The fan hit my right wrist, and the scar it left on it is still, years later, in the shadowed shape of a triangle, always reminding me of the Holy Trinity's saving power. This is the great miracle of Merciful Love in my life. All glory to our God in the highest and our Most Merciful Mother. Every doctor caring for these injuries said, "If he had hit you a second time, you would have had a skull fracture, brain bleed, and died." The most precious miracle of my wholehearted conversion followed this event, and there are thousands of other related miracles, but safe to say, the desperately love-struck LORD joyfully waits to prove His faithfulness, His *hesed*, to us.

(Editor's note – Alyssa Marie is so tiny and young-looking I was amazed to learn she was a Franciscan University student and I am even more astounded now, reading her story, that she had survived such a brutal attack as described. Please keep Alyssa Marie in prayer as she discerns a life of service to the poor as a religious sister.)

### **Eucharistic Adoration**

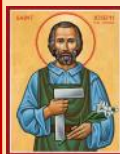

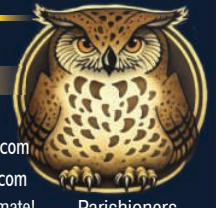
