



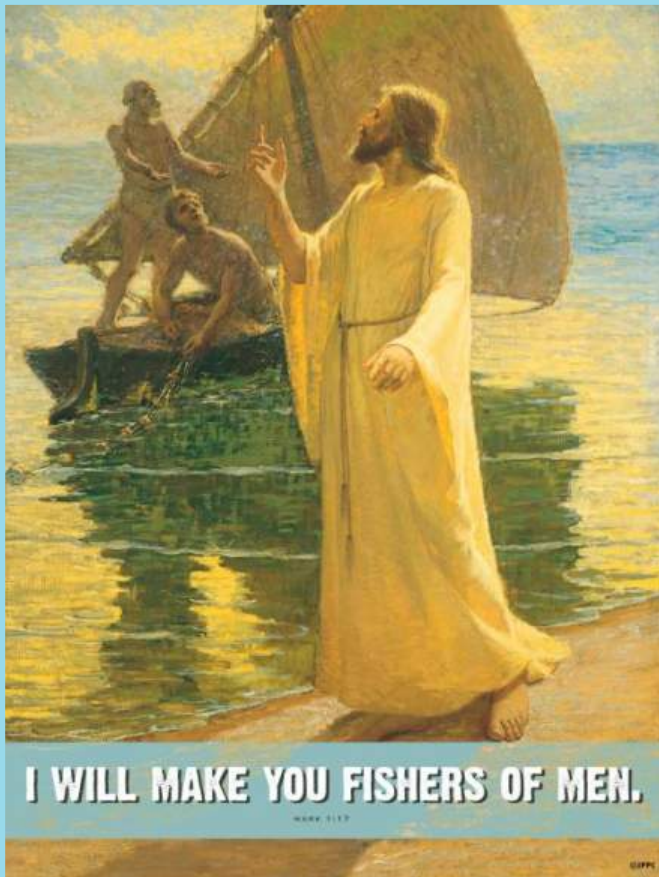

What is a QCD?

Starting at age 73 the IRS mandates [typically, traditional] IRA owners to take annual income withdrawals, known as Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs). Failure to take these withdrawals could subject IRA owners to stiff penalties.

Thankfully, charitably-minded individuals and couples age 70½ and older have a tax-smart strategy called a qualified charitable distribution (QCD), also known as a charitable IRA rollover.

The IRA assets go directly to charity, for example, Sacred Heart Parish, so donors don't report QCDs as taxable income and don't owe any taxes on the QCD, even if they do not itemize deductions! Some donors may also find that QCDs provide greater tax savings than cash donations for which charitable tax deductions are claimed.
