RECEPTION OF THE PENITENT

PRIEST: Welcomes the penitent.

PENITENT: IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, AND THE SON, AND THE HOLY SPIRIT. AMEN.

PRIEST: Invites the penitent to have trust in God.

READING OF THE WORD OF GOD (OPTIONAL)

The priest or penitent may read a text of Holy Scripture.

CONFESSION OF SINS AND ACCEPTANCE OF SATISFACTION

PENITENT: BLESS ME, FATHER, FOR I HAVE SINNED. IT HAS BEEN (say how long it has been) SINCE MY LAST CONFESSION. THESE ARE MY SINS:

Tell the priest your sins with honesty and sorrow, and also tell the priest a little about yourself.

The priest will listen to you and guide you.

PENITENT:

I AM SORRY FOR THESE AND ALL MY SINS.

The priest will give you a penance to help make up for your sins and to change your heart.

PRAYER OF THE PENITENT AND ABSOLUTION

PENITENT: O MY GOD, I AM HEARTILY SORRY FOR HAVING OFFENDED YOU AND I DETEST ALL MY SINS BECAUSE OF YOUR JUST PUNISHMENT. BUT MOST OF ALL, BECAUSE THEY OFFEND YOU MY GOD WHO ARE ALL GOOD AND DESERVING OF ALL MY LOVE. I FIRMLY RESOLVE WITH THE HELP OF YOUR GRACE TO SIN NO MORE AND TO AVOID THE NEAR OCCASION OF SIN. AMEN.

> After the Act of Contrition, the priest will give you Absolution. At the end of the Absolution, make the sign of the cross and say, **AMEN.**

PROCLAMATION OF PRAISE AND DISMISSAL

- PRIEST: Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good.
- PENITENT: HIS MERCY ENDURES FOREVER.
- PRIEST: Dismisses the penitent in peace.
