

Miracles Happen Here

Anyone who has been here from the beginning with Fr. Anthony knows of his history with miracles. The greatest miracle that Father gives us is Mass and the sacraments where he brings us Jesus in the Eucharist daily and forgiveness in confession thrice weekly. These and the other sacraments are the power of God the Father through the apostolic succession over 21 centuries. But that we may believe in that authority, we have been given outward signs.

Father Anthony has witnessed many miracles in his life, but here he tells of his favorite one:

My Dad had struggled with back pain due to spinal injury for thirteen years. The pain had been so debilitating, that he had lost jobs and we had to move to a smaller, more affordable house. Still Dad's pain was relentless, and it became increasingly difficult for him to work. We had come to the point where we were facing possible foreclosure and hopelessness was beginning to set in.

Around that time, I was tossing a football around with dad at flag football practice. To my surprise, he was moving around comfortably, even picking up the ball when it fell. He shouldn't have been able to do that, but I shrugged it off thinking that maybe dad was having a good day. Perhaps a week later, dad called a family meeting. He had some good news to share.

About a week ago, he woke up with no back pain. He couldn't believe it! He didn't even tell mom for a couple of days. When he did, she told him that the night before this happened, she had cried herself to sleep praying. They had six kids, money was short, and they were going to have to sell the house. She prayed to St. Joseph, patron saint of workers. And she prayed to André, my brother who passed away at only a month old. He's closer to God than any of us, so mom asked him to get his dad a job. Medical testing revealed that the nerve damage was still there, but the pain was not. No explanation for that! This is the strength of prayer and faith.

Father's story is one of hope and healing. Jesus's story is filled with these kinds of answered prayers. A lame man lowered through the roof as his friends faithfully request healing (Lk5:17-39), the beggings of the centurion for his comatose slave (Mt 8:5-13), and the father's pleading for the cure of his possessed son (Mk9:14-29) are all examples of healing through the intercession of the prayers of a loved one. Pray for each other always. God Bless You.

Blessing of Easter Food Baskets Saturday, April 4th at 12:00pm In the Church

A Holy Saturday Tradition: The blessing of Easter baskets is a cherished Catholic tradition, particularly among families of Eastern European descent, which takes place on Holy Saturday.

The baskets, often adorned with ribbons and lined with white cloth, hold symbolic foods representing the end of Lent and the joy of the Resurrection. Families bring their baskets to church to be blessed by a priest/deacon, who sprinkles them with holy water and offers prayers. After the blessing, the food is taken home and shared with family and guests on Easter Sunday.

The foods in the basket carry symbolic meaning, such as eggs (representing new life and the Resurrection), bread (symbolizing Jesus), and salt (representing purification).

FACILITIES COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Committee has made good progress on several large projects in recent months. Here's some highlights. The largest project in progress, the new HVAC system for the Church, is on track to be completed this summer. We selected Craft & Sons mechanical contractors, based in Manchester, PA to execute the project.

Craft was selected from amongst three qualified commercial contractors who bid on the project. Nine contractors were solicited to bid. The Archdiocese recently approved the project and is preparing the contract for Craft's signature.

During the engineering phase of the project, old and abandoned duct work was discovered above the narthex and sacristy which has to be removed to make space for new air handlers. We are installing three separate units, a 30-ton unit to serve the church only and two smaller units to serve the sacristy, chapel/cry room, and the narthex. This configuration will provide greater control over temperatures in these spaces and lower our energy usage.

It is likely, given the long lead times for equipment delivery, we will have to hold Masses in the gym this summer. We'll make that decision in early summer as we see how the weather and the project are progressing (and how the old unit is performing)!

In the Parish Center, we completed two large projects: the replacement/upgrade of the emergency power backup system which powers critical lighting in the building during a power outage or fire, and piping upgrades to the fire suppression / sprinkler system.

Our next large project at the Parish Center will be to replace the roof over the cafeteria and possibly the gym. You may recall we replaced the roof over the classrooms in 2022. Numerous leaks occurred in the cafeteria this winter despite attempts to patch it last year. Once we've inspected the gym roof more closely, we'll determine the full scope of work.


