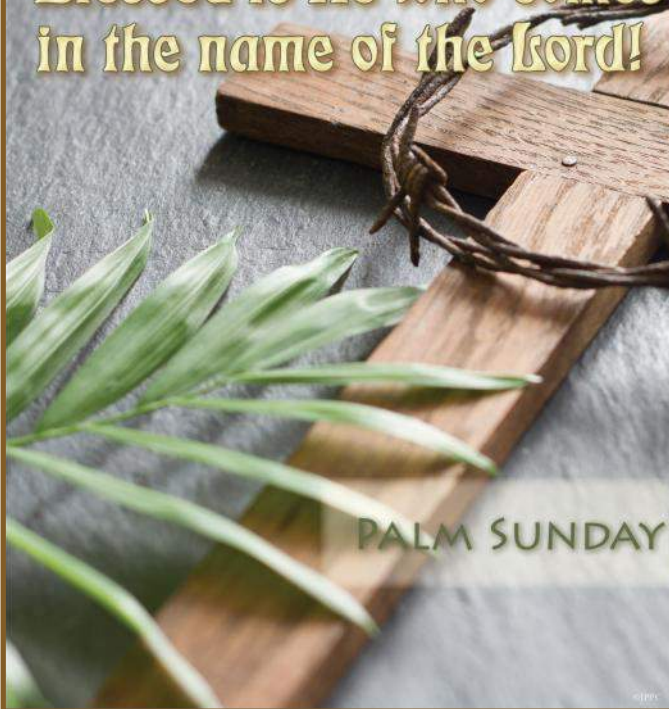

### BLESSING OF EASTER BASKETS Holy Saturday at Noon

Swieconka(sh-vee-en-soon-kah) is one of the most enduring and beloved Polish traditions. Baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday.

The foods in the baskets have a symbolic meaning:  
eggs – symbolize life and Christ's resurrection  
bread – symbolic of Jesus  
lamb – represents Christ  
salt – represents purification  
horseradish – symbolic of the bitter sacrifice of Christ  
ham – symbolic of great joy and abundance.

The food blessed in the church remains untouched according to traditions until either Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning.

### *Eucharistic Adoration--Lent*

After the Last Supper, Jesus went with His friends to the Garden of Gethsemani and there He asked them, “*Could you not watch one hour with me?*” (Mt 26: 40) This is the same invitation that Jesus asks us. So, instead of giving up “treats” this Lent, why not consider spending some quiet time with Our Lord Jesus Christ. Eucharistic Adoration is open to all and is held every **Tuesday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:45 p.m.**, followed by Benediction and concludes with Holy Mass at 7:00 p.m. You may come at any time and stay for any length of time.

**On Holy Thursday evening (April 17, 2025), we will have Adoration from 8:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. in the Main Church (close to the Saint Joseph Statue).**
