Miracles Happen Here

These are the signs that **will** be associated with believers: in my name they **will** cast out devils; they **will** have the gift of tongues; they **will** pick up snakes in their hands and be unharmed should they drink deadly poison; they **will** lay their hands on the sick, who **will** recover.' (Mark 16:17-18)

The Catholic Church is the church that Jesus Himself founded. It is baffling, that so few of our glorious gifts are well-known in the wider world today. Jesus performed miracles as a visible sign of His authority. (Matthew 9:1-13) That authority has been passed down to His church. From Marian apparitions associated with predictions that have come true, to the unexplainable Shroud of Turin, which gets more mystifying as the science studying it becomes more sophisticated, Catholicism is steeped in the supernatural. Our rich legacy of Saints who performed unbelievable feats and healings to battles won by prayer and trust in the Lord, our history shouts of a God so powerful and so merciful. He is well beyond human understanding. The stories of saints and miracles of long ago seem like tall tales on the order of the superhero genre so popular with younger generations. But miracles, spectacular and quiet, still happen today – and they happen here. Telling our stories of how God has reached into our lives and changed us forever is key in drawing people back home to the church that Jesus gave mankind.

Most of us have at least one life-changing miracle in our lives. We might think it was luck, or a coincidence – a pileup on the highway that you weren't involved in because you inexplicably left the house five minutes earlier than planned, or an unexpected five dollar bill in a rarely used jacket's pocket that bought a homeless man a cup of coffee on a cold winter day. There are the ones that are clearly answers to fervent prayers. Maybe you were given a terrifying diagnosis which, after prayer (and maybe even medical intervention) leaves you healthy and whole - but with a deeper sense of God's love. Or maybe your miracle involves a chance encounter that blossoms into blessings heretofore unimagined. Did a dream like those of the Josephs in both the old and new testaments direct you in God's way? Miracles can sometimes involve animals, things, strangers, and even locutions (where we hear audibly the advice we need). The creativity of God's touch is endless. How has He touched you? If you have a miracle story in your life – please share it with our parish family and maybe someone who needs to know where God lives, will come home to Sacred Heart.






