# From The PASTOR

This weekend's column is written by parishioner Janine Jordan-Mueller, MD. She is an internist. She and her husband Thomas Mueller, MD, who is a neurologist, recently went to India as volunteers for a medical mission.

“Trust and Trust alone should lead us to Love” —Therese of Lisieux

When my husband and I volunteered for a Medical Mission to India, we were not sure what to expect, but we trusted that God would guide our efforts, and that our work would be fruitful.

We arrived in Ashram, a facility run by a physician following Mother Teresa's precedent, which houses the dispossessed; men, women and children who have been abandoned. Our task was to aid in clinical diagnosis, treatment of disease and teaching of medical students who were our translators. Many of the illnesses were truly Biblical in scope like leprosy, complicated seizure disorders, and wounds that required extensive debridement. The work was intense and rather rigorous as there were over 5,000 residents that needed to be seen. Both the staff and the patients, however, could not have been more grateful and loving. We returned home with a love for the Indian people, their culture, and a deep appreciation for all the blessings and opportunities of our own country and most importantly, a new found understanding of love and faith. Trust did lead us to Love.


