## **~ Prayer to Saint Michael ~**

## *Miracles Happen Here*

There are times when things are shown to us and only much later are we given the understanding of what we have seen. The presence of types in the Bible that foreshadow the coming of Mary as the Theotokos as God-bearer is pre-figured by the Ark of the Covenant in the Old Testament. The virtuous women who came before the perfect one are examples along the path from fallen Eve back to God's favor in the perfection of Mary, Our Mother. On a more personal level, we are sometimes given a glimpse of the hidden supernatural in our personal lives and we subsequently get the opportunity to recognize what we have been shown. The analogy isn't perfect, but the following is an occurrence of an early premonition which came to be explained later in life and ended up in a valuable lesson for all time.

As a little boy alone and kept in the dark because of a case of the measles, an unnatural, fiery red-orange ball appeared in a far corner of the bedroom. As I watched, the thing grew and the surface roiled. An extremely cruel mouth appeared and this was soon accompanied by a nose of some kind which somehow was as menacing. Wild animals such as wolves and boars loomed threateningly from the horrible surface and looked straight at me. I was terrified and wanted to run, but I couldn't move. After what felt like a long time, the thing eventually faded but I never forgot what I saw.

Years later, there was a self-professed mystic in New York named Veronica Leuken who, while never recognized by the official church, yet she attracted a large following, myself included. Her predictions and warnings were spot-on and many of the signs she revealed came by way of Polaroid photos. These, for our younger readers, are physical pictures that would come out of the camera and develop before your eyes. I'd become a devoted follower, and during one session, she said she would take a picture and it would reveal the devil. As the picture taken that day developed, I saw exactly the same creature I had seen so many years earlier as a measles patient!

With the kind of affirmation I had received from this holy lady, I began reciting nine rosaries per day-three each of the three mysteries that were customary before Pope St. John Paul II introduced Thursday Luminous Mysteries on Thursdays. I was willing to do whatever necessary to bring about God's plan for humanity. In my confidence, I requested the opportunity to become a suffering soul. Not long afterward, I came down with viral rheumatic arthritis which would disappear whenever I went to see a specialist. This was the most painful thing I had ever experienced. There wasn't a spot in or on my body that didn't hurt. In the morning, the pain was bearable, but by the end of the day, it was unendurable. It lasted two months the first time I had it and one month the second year. At the point where I just could not endure one more second of the agony, I prayed, "I can't do this," A voice answered, "You're acting like a child," and the pain left me for good. God answered each and every prayer. He gave me the opportunity I had requested, and He relieved me of the responsibility when I could no longer withstand the ordeal.

We are reminded of St. Peter when he asked Jesus to have him walk on the water through the stormy sea to his Master. Jesus said, "Come." Then Peter became overwhelmed. Immediately, Jesus reached out His hand and saved his apostle.

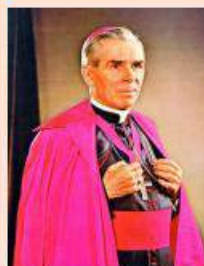
