MIRACLES HAPPEN HERE

We tend to assign the term "angel" to people who step up when we are not in a position to help ourselves. As Catholics, we are taught that people are not angels and will never become angels based on the belief in the resurrection of the body. Angels are pure spirit and as such have no bodily component. It is comforting, however, to see rescuers as our angels and this is one such perspective submitted by Kelly and Phil Leyman.

Angels come in many forms - they are stewards and stewardesses, police officers, and pilots. But they are also everyday people. Our angels are the men and women of Gander, Newfoundland.

On September 11, 2001, my husband and I departed Ireland for the USA. We wanted to arrive home on the 12th to celebrate our daughter's birthday.

The flight started out peaceful. Everyone was enjoying each other's company. The mood changed when the steward and stewardesses began walking up and down the aisle crying. We didn't know what had happened until the pilot announced that two planes crashed into the Twin Towers and we were going to land in Gander, Newfoundland.

We landed in Gander but had to stay on the plane for 13 hours. We finally departed the plane and were transported to a local church. Then, our Canadian angels appeared, dressed like everyday people. Our angels shared their homes, their food, and even their clothing.

This is a reminder that angels are everywhere among us dressed in plain clothes. Thank you to the angels of Gander, Newfoundland who kept us safe.

The Catholic definition of angel is a spiritual being sent to act as an attendant, a messenger, or an agent. It is easy to see how the dear people of Gander could be seen as angels in the above situation.
