

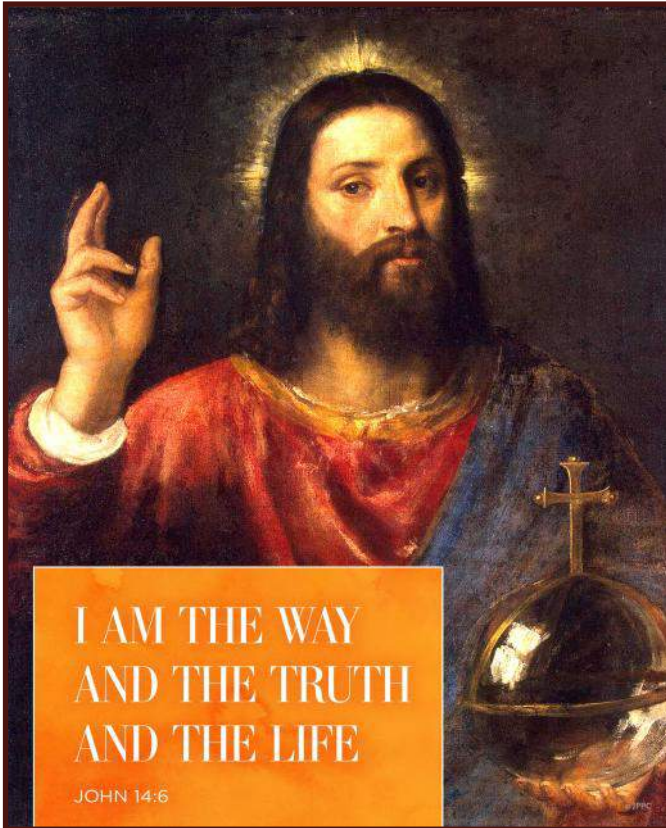

Miracles Happen Here

One type of miracle that has been seen throughout human history is where God Himself lets us know clearly what our role in His story is to be. Like St. Paul's conversion story (Acts 9:3-6), the following is a miracle story in which obedience to His instruction bears great fruit.

From Parishioners John and Kathy Maloney:

This miracle started with a word from God Himself and required trust and obedience on our part.

It happened in 2011 when our granddaughter was 3. We were to have her overnight on a Saturday. This meant she would be attending Mass with us. The last time we took her was very challenging. She did not listen and was all over the place. Attending church was not something her family did. So, I decided I would go Saturday night, and my wife would go Sunday. That way the granddaughter could stay home.

However, all day long on Saturday, I kept hearing the Lord say, "You are keeping my daughter from me". I tried ignoring it and finally said to God, "Okay. Then You are going to have to make it work". I told my wife, and we did take her on Sunday. Before going, Grandmom had a talk with her, telling her that we would be sitting in the "little church" meaning the cry room. She needed to walk, not run. She was to be very quiet, still, and listen to Grandmom and Pop-pop. When we entered the narthex, she was very quiet and tiptoed to the "little church" and settled herself once inside. She was like a little angel all through Mass. God surely did make it work and so much more!

The following Sunday we visited her as usual. Her mother told us that our granddaughter had asked if they were going to church today. The answer was no. Her mother told us that if we wanted to get her every week, it would be fine with her if our granddaughter went with us. That is what happened for the following 4 years. She enjoyed the children's liturgy that was offered at that time. After Mass, she would spend several hours at our house with us. Oh, what pleasant memories and oh, the things she learned about God!!

She has never been baptized, But I am sure that someday it will happen. She is now about to graduate High School and has had a lot of trials. Many times, I have reminded God that she is His daughter and He has to make it work, which He does over and over. Over the years, when she gives us gifts, it is usually of a spiritual nature. Examples: crosses, angels etc. She has asked us to pray for different people many times. She may not be baptized but she definitely is a child of God. We thank Him for all He has done and will do in her life every day!!

This story reminds us that as long as we do our part, The Lord will do His part—in His own unique time. Trust and obedience are powerful tools when coupled with gratitude can change lives.

Young at Heart meets the first and third Mondays of each month, September through May at 1:00pm in the Parish Hall.

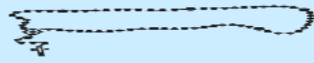
Please come to a meeting and enjoy the camaraderie and fun. There is coffee and tea, and members always bring treats to share.

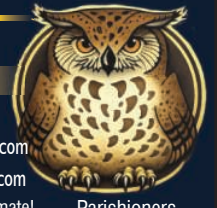
