



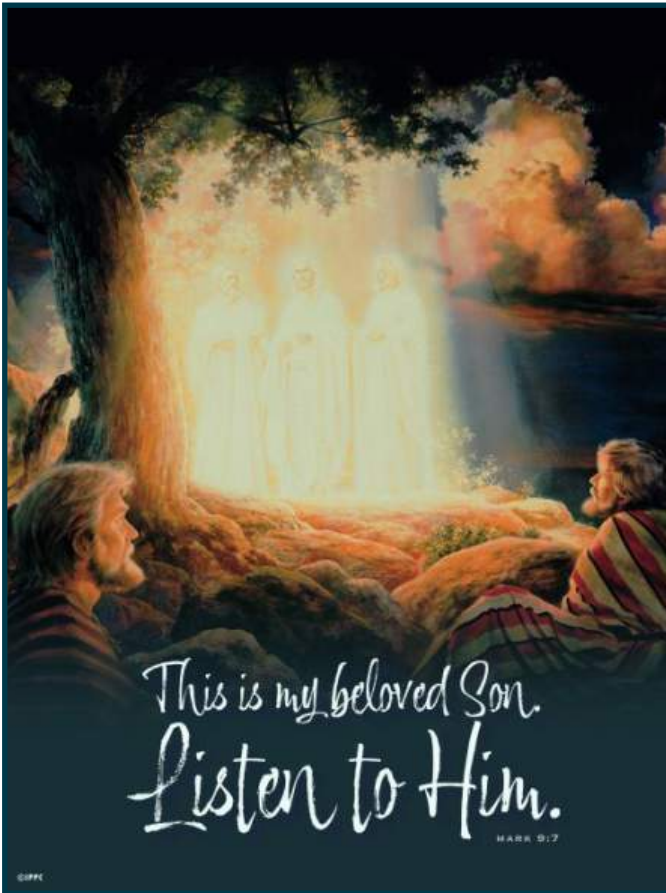

PARISH FINANCIAL UPDATE

In the table to the right you will find our Parish's income statement for the first six months of fiscal 2024 as compared to full year results for 2021 through 2023.

The six month period ended December 31, 2023. For that six month period, the Parish generated \$119 thousand of income on total revenue of \$635 thousand and operating expenses of \$515 thousand.

A portion of this income, \$56 thousand, was invested in major improvements to our campus and to pay down our bank loan. We ended the period with \$1,010K of cash in the bank.

For the first half of the year, we saw higher operating expense versus prior years due to increased maintenance and people costs. Conversely, utilities were down due to moderate weather and investments in energy saving projects. Revenues, in total, were in line with previous years.

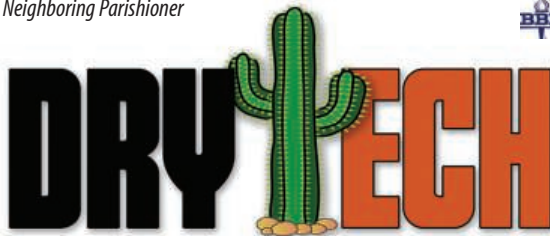
