Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

This Wednesday, February 14th, is Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of Lent. Lent is a privileged time in the life of the Church to allow God's grace to change our hearts. On Ash Wednesday, we will have Mass with the distribution of ashes at 8 am, 12 Noon, and 7 pm. According to the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, the Church's discipline regarding fasting and abstinence from meat for Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and for abstinence from meat on Fridays during Lent, is as follows:

"Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards"(<https://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/liturgical-year-and-calendar/lent/catholic-information-on-lenten-fast-and-abstinence>, accessed on 02/14/2023).

Several outside priests from surrounding parishes and from Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary will be at our parish that evening to hear Confessions. I warmly invite you to take advantage of this opportunity to receive the forgiveness of Jesus in this beautiful sacrament of mercy.

I wish you all a very fruitful Lent.

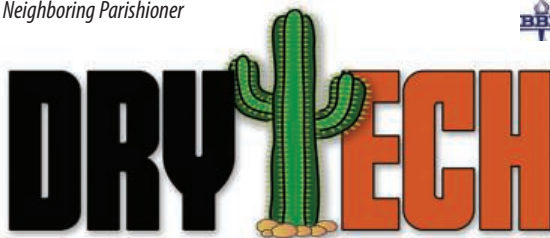
