## Miracles Happen Here

Throughout the history of the Church's devotion to Our Blessed Lady, roses have always been associated with her presence and care. There have been many reports of the sweet floral accompaniment whenever she has bestowed favors on her children. Here is a story in which the phenomenon comforts and brings healing to an anonymous Sacred Heart couple.

Back in the late 90's, I had a miscarriage early in our marriage which was my first pregnancy, and it devastated my husband and me. We moved on after a while as we knew we would try again, but it took me longer to get over it and I became depressed. At that time, we were parishioners of St. Anthony of Padua Parish in Wilmington. One Saturday afternoon my husband and I were going to confession there. They have the old style confessionals on the sides of the church about halfway down the aisle. For those who are not familiar with St. Anthony's, it is a huge basilica with many side altars of various saints. My husband and I were the only people in the church for confession. We were sitting in the middle of the church near the confessionals, very far from the main altar. There were no flowers anywhere in the church, nor was I wearing any kind of lotion or perfume. After we both went to confession, still the only ones in the church, we were kneeling in the pew and saying our prayers. All of a sudden, I smelled roses right underneath my nose. It was a potent, sweet smell as if a bouquet of roses was right there! I turned to my husband and said, "Do you smell roses?" He exclaimed, "Yes!" We looked around again, especially at the front altar, to see if there were any type of roses or flowers and there was nothing! Within seconds, the scent of roses disappeared from beneath our noses as instantly as it came to us.

I truly believe our Blessed Mother manifested herself to us during our difficult time to let us know she was with us. We were so blessed to have received this special grace from heaven. I have read where people have smelled roses when Mary is present, and I can truly say this was a miracle. After another difficult miscarriage sometime later, I finally had my daughter who was baptized and married at St. Anthony's! Although we haven't been parishioners there for many years, St. Anthony's still holds a special place in our hearts after our direct encounter with Our Blessed Mother. She truly works miracles for us and gives us the courage to endure hardships as we press onward in living our Faith.

The miracle of Our Lady of Guadalupe in December 1531 was affirmed by roses collected out of season by the peasant Juan Diego and presented to the authorities as proof of the veracity of her intercession for the conversion of Mexico.

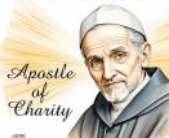
