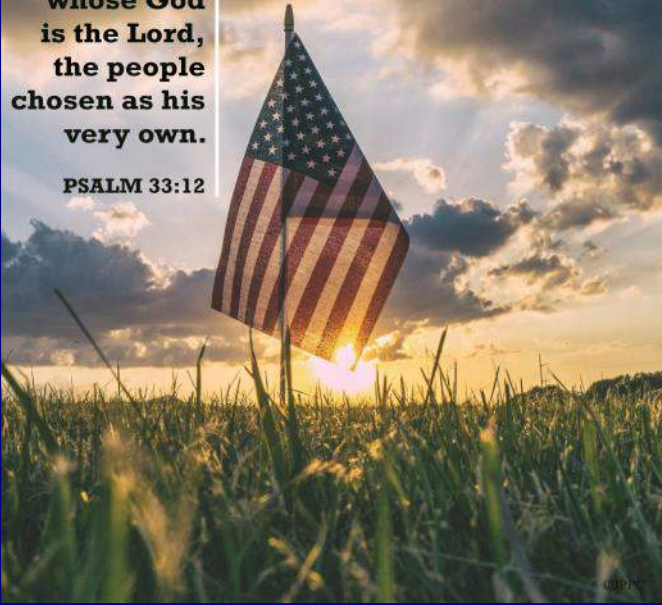

Miracles Happen Here

Luke 12:12 tells us we will be prompted by the Holy Spirit when we need Divine help. Sometimes He comes to us even when we are unaware of the necessity. The following is an example of one such incident:

From an anonymous parishioner appropriately received on Memorial Day:

Back in the early 1980's, I was an active duty Marine Corps Captain and had just been assigned as officer in charge of the Marine Corps Reserve Center in Delaware County. I was about 30 years old and had already served in various other capacities at Marine Corp bases within and outside the United States.

I was a cradle Catholic and tried to attend Mass on Sunday when time permitted. Of my many responsibilities the one I was hoping to avoid was making a 'casualty call' to the family in the event of the death of their Marine son or daughter. I was told to always have a set of Dress Blues ready to go in the event I received a call. My areas of responsibility were Delaware and Chester counties. In the event of a death, a call would go from Headquarters Marine Corps in Washington DC to a Colonel stationed in Philadelphia and then to me. The intent was to make notification to the family before they heard from anyone else or from the news media.

A young Marine whose parents lived near Villanova was riding in the back of a helicopter and was killed when it crashed in the Sea of Japan. I believe he was a helicopter mechanic.

The 1st Sgt. and myself quickly dressed into our Blues. He pulled up the van as I hunted through the paper street map of Delaware County. There was no GPS or cell phones back then. As we navigated toward the house and were stopped at a red light near Villanova, I looked to my right and saw a big Catholic church, something (the Holy Spirit) popped into my head telling me to go into the church and ask if they knew this family. I told the 1st Sgt to pull into the rectory parking lot. Going in, I met the secretary and explained. She told me to wait a minute. An elderly priest came out, probably the monsignor. I told him what was going on. He said the family are parishioners and he knows them well. He immediately and without hesitation said he would ride with us and within minutes we were in the van. He knew the back streets to get to the house.

The house was set down in a small slope from the street. As we got out, the mother obviously saw us thru the window as we could hear her screaming from inside the house. The front door was locked and we could hear the screams now coming from the back of the house. We ran around the side and the priest grabbed her and held on as she tried to run. Understandably, she was hysterical but the priest held on and talked to her. Her husband was at work and we all stayed until he came home and explained as much as we knew. Other family members and neighbors started showing up. The 1st Sgt and I eventually left. The priest stayed with the family.

Once I got to a phone, I advised the Colonel that the notification had been made. The young Marine had been stationed at one of our bases near Japan. The Commanding Officer and other Marines who personally knew the deceased flew in to participate in the funeral. Some of the Marines on my staff took care of the administrative part since we were close by to support the family.

It was not until much later, as I kept replaying what had transpired, that I understood it had to be the Holy Spirit that prompted me to pull into that church and prompted that priest to be so willing and ready to comfort that mother and family. It also shows the dedication and commitment of our Catholic priests.

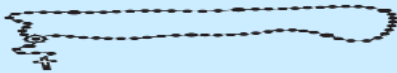



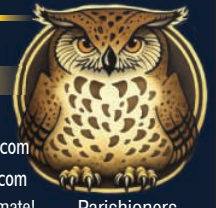
