Miracles Happen Here

There are miracles in the Bible that involve the cooperation of creation in order to further God's plan. In chapters seven through eleven of Exodus, we hear of gnats, locusts, frogs, and flies convincingly persuading Pharaoh of the might of the true God. In the following account, Our Father is a bit more subtle, but no less effective.

A story told by Deacon Jim Munos of St. Mary of the Mills, Laurel, MD (Archdiocese of Washington):

Even the best parents often raise children who "go off the rails" sometimes. Deacon Jim and his wife, Anita, had raised their children in the faith and had been sorely disappointed when their oldest son moved in with his non-Catholic girlfriend without making her his wife. They spent many nights in prayer together, asking Our Mother of the Miraculous Medal to intercede on behalf of the wayward couple.

So when their son announced that he and his girlfriend were going to be married, the parents were elated. That is, until they found out that they intended to have an outdoor, New Age ceremony on the wooded property owned by the young woman and her friends. Deacon Jim did what he does best: he began to pray over the situation.

Nothing changed, and invitations were mailed. A different arrangement for the vows was made, and the church was not a part of it. Then, when it seemed like time had run out, the girls were making final preparations at the venue. As they were clearing the area, they found themselves covered with itchy bites. Microscopic oak mites had infested the trees and would surely ruin the wedding!

Hat in hand, the groom sheepishly asked if the church directly across the street from the woods was still available for that day. It was! So signs were put up directing the guests into the sanctuary, where the Deacon assisted at the sacrament for his eldest son and his bride.

Afterward, Deacon Jim was marveling at the turn of events with his associate pastor. In his understated way, Father Christian said, "All God's creatures work for His purpose."

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HVAC UPDATE

We're pleased to report that our contractor, Craft & Sons, is making great progress on the new HVAC system for the church.

They recently completed the lift necessary to remove the old unit and install the new 30-ton unit, which will serve the church proper. Craft will also be installing two smaller units in coming weeks, one of which will serve the narthex, while the second will serve the sacristy and cry room. This configuration will allow us to condition the air in these smaller spaces without having to turn on the 30-ton unit serving the church.

If all continues as planned, we'll be back in the church in early September.

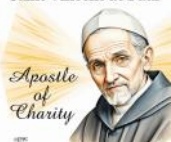
